In the run-up to this year’s general election, we brought together leading politicians from the three main Westminster parties at a special policy conference.

The event marked the publication of our manifesto, *Skills for Prosperity*, which attracted cross-party support.

We have built on our manifesto proposals and promoted fresh thinking on significant public policy challenges with our new Policy Solution series: *No Limits*, details a

career advancement service to help the UK’s 5 million low paid workers. *Making Migration Work* identifies workable policies to unlock the benefits of migration, while supporting all workers to become more resilient and more employable.
