



Diverse City is a simple class game that allows teachers and learners to identify a business within a fictional city. The game allows learners to pick people with different characteristics and to discuss the roles they will best suit in the business. Different types of discrimination and sexual orientation are all considered.

# How to play



**The Diverse City board can be printed or used with an interactive white Board**

Whole group to decide on type of business and company name

1. Group create roles for their company
2. The cards are placed face down in two piles, one of red cards and one of yellow cards.

(yellow) Types of people e.g. Man, woman, teenager.

(red) Types of sexual orientation

4. A card is turned from each pile to create an applicant profile

## How to play (Continued...)



5. Group discuss if they would or would not employ this person and in what role. Their reasons will be explained and discussed and the group will need to negotiate until a majority decision is reached
6. Themes of discussion will include what skills and qualities, strengths and needs each candidate may have and what they might bring to the company
7. Chosen cards are placed on the board

# Sexual orienteering terminology



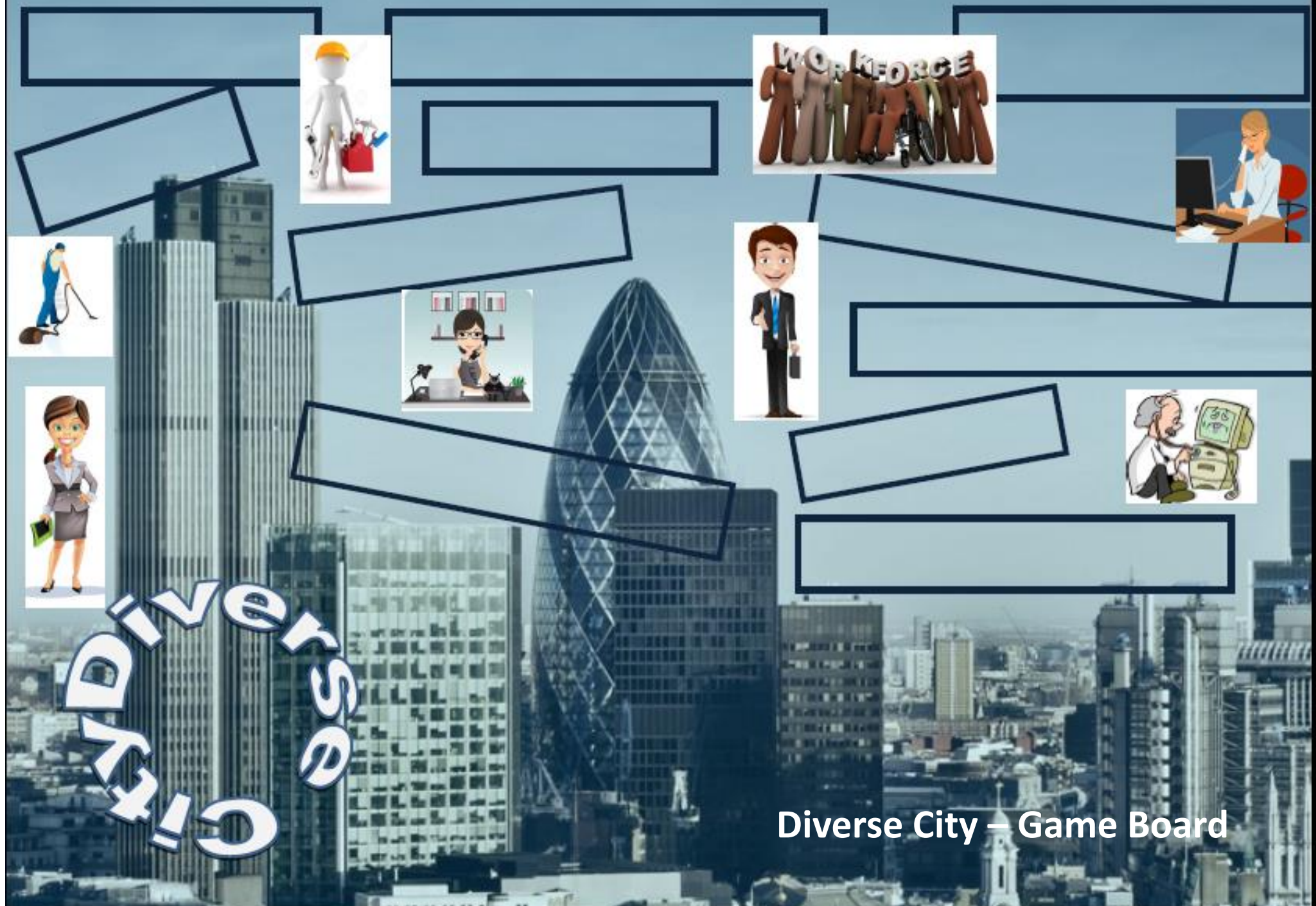
- **Transgender** – relating to a person who wants to belong to the opposite sex. Identifying as having undergone or undergoing medical treatment to become a member of the opposite sex
- **Transsexual** – having physical characteristics of one sex and psychological characteristics of the other
- **Bisexual** – sexually attracted to members of both sexes
- **Gay** – person who is sexually attracted only by person of his or her own sex
- **Transvestite** – someone who wears clothes of the opposite sex
- **Lesbian** – female who is only sexually attracted to the female sex

# Sexual orienteering terminology



- **Heterosexual** – person who is sexually attracted to the opposite sex
- **Marriage** – a legal union between two people; a man and a woman, a man and a man or a woman and a woman, usually entailing legal obligations of each to the other
- **Civil partnerships** – a legal union or partnership, similar to marriage, between two people; a man and a woman, a man and a man or a woman and a woman
