Workshop C

Learning Dreams, a model developed by the University of Minnesota, (<http://learningdreams.org/>) builds a culture of learning in families and communities, by getting parents to engage with their own learning dreams - things they had a passion for when they were younger or had a yearning to do. As parents become engaged in their own learning, they create a learning culture in the family with supports the learning outcomes of their children. When this happens in a number of families it creates a learning community. This model is also being tested in The Hague, Netherlands, and a pilot has recently started in north and west Belfast neighbourhoods. The workshop will be led by Dr Jerry Stein the founder of Learning Dreams.

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
